The Ava R-1 School District is excited to provide **Bears Den**, a before and after school program, funded by the Federal 21st Century Community Learning Centers grant. The **Bears Den** Program is designed to provide a safe, positive place for kids to stay before and after school that offers fun and engaging activities, builds successful and productive citizens and is affordable for our working parents.

Bears Den is available for all students in PK- 8th grade. The elementary morning program runs from 6:45 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. each morning. Middle School kids will check in at 7:00 in the MS gym. Elementary kids will check in at the elementary cafeteria. The afternoon program runs from 3:15 p.m. to 5:45 p.m. each day. Students will check in and go to recess for a few minutes. A snack will be served. Students will then work on homework or reading/math skills for 30 minutes (4:00-4:30). The program will finish with enrichment activities (4:30-5:30) and student choice activities. Tutoring will begin the first week in October for those students who qualify. Tutoring should be finished by 4:30 each evening.

Parent pick-up for the elementary Bears Den is in back of the elementary building at the second grade hallway on East Broadway Ave. Middle school students will be picked up at the Bear Cave on Spring Street. Students MUST be signed out and picked up by their parents or people listed on the enrollment form by 5:45 each night. Parent pick-up doors will open at 3:45 p.m. AFTER the buses leave the campus. Parents wanting to pick up their students before 3:45 need to use the regular school parent pick-up line. There is bus transportation home each night with designated routes and stops similar to Summer School. Buses will leave the campus each night at 5:35 p.m.

Bears Den is very affordable for families. The cost is \$1 per day for students on free lunches. \$2 per day for students on reduced lunches and \$3 per day for students on full-priced lunches. There is a family cap of \$25 per week. If a child attends both the morning and the afternoon program the family will only be charged once for the day. If a family cannot afford these prices there is a scholarship available. No kids will be denied attending due to the cost of the program. No weekly or monthly statements will be sent home. The gatekeeper can let you know what amount you owe and will take payments each night so a receipt can be given to you for documentation.

Day Camps will be offered each month when the district holds a teacher inservice day and during holiday breaks. The camps will run from 6:45 a.m. until 5:45 each day. There will be NO TRANSPORTATION home on these days. Parents are responsible for drop off and pick up.
